Under Turki Bin Abdullah Al Saud's son Faisal (grandfather of King Abdulaziz, the Founder of the present Kingdom) the rule of Al Saud extended over much of central and eastern Arabia and after the death of Faisal, Riyadh was ruled by Abdullah, and it was he who in the 19860's built Al Musmak Fort which played an important part in the founding of the modern Saudi State.

King Abdulaziz Historical Center

The King Abdulaziz Historical Centre was constructed to mark the occasion of the centenary of Riyadh's recapture by King Abdulaziz 100 years ago, and to become a national landmark for Saudi Arabia. The King Abdulaziz Historical Center reflects the Culture of the Peninsula's history, Islam's eternal message, and the basis on which the Kingdom was founded

The Old City of Diriyah

During the period of the first Saudi State (late 17th Century and early 19th Century AD) when Saudi power extended over most of the Arabian Peninsula, the capital of the House of Saud was Ad-Diriyah, north of Ar-Riyadh on high ground above Wadi Hanifa. Riyadh was incorporated into the first Saudi State in 1773 AD and for 45 years enjoyed peace and security firm religious discipline under Saudi rule based in Ad-Diriyah
